That is why the Supreme Buddha is called

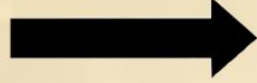

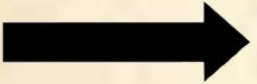

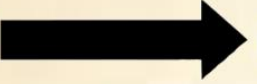
